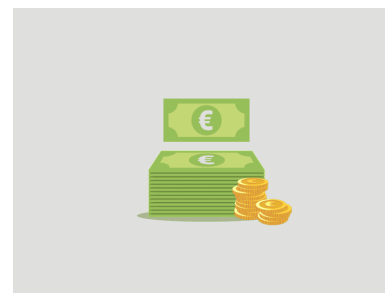

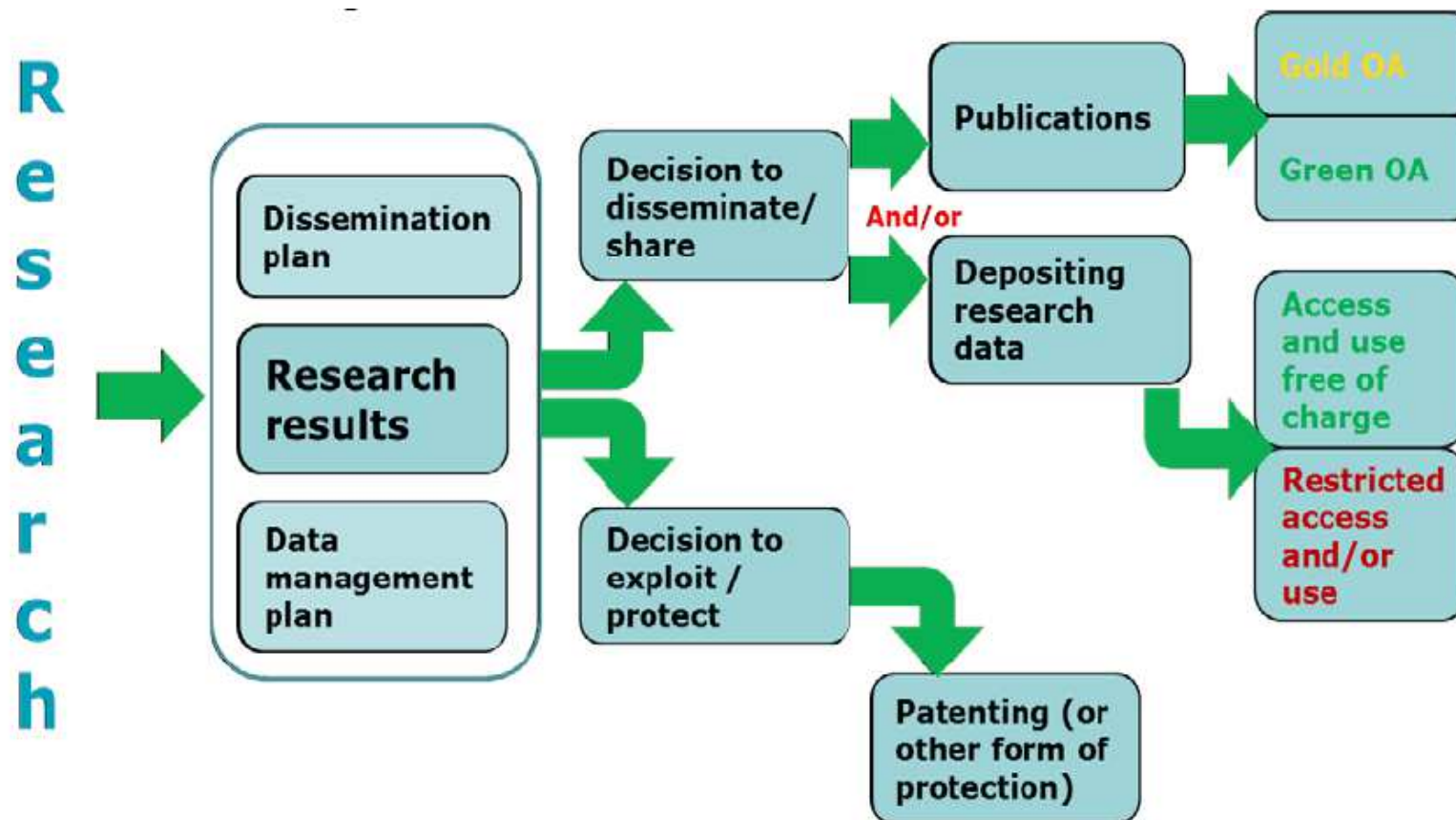

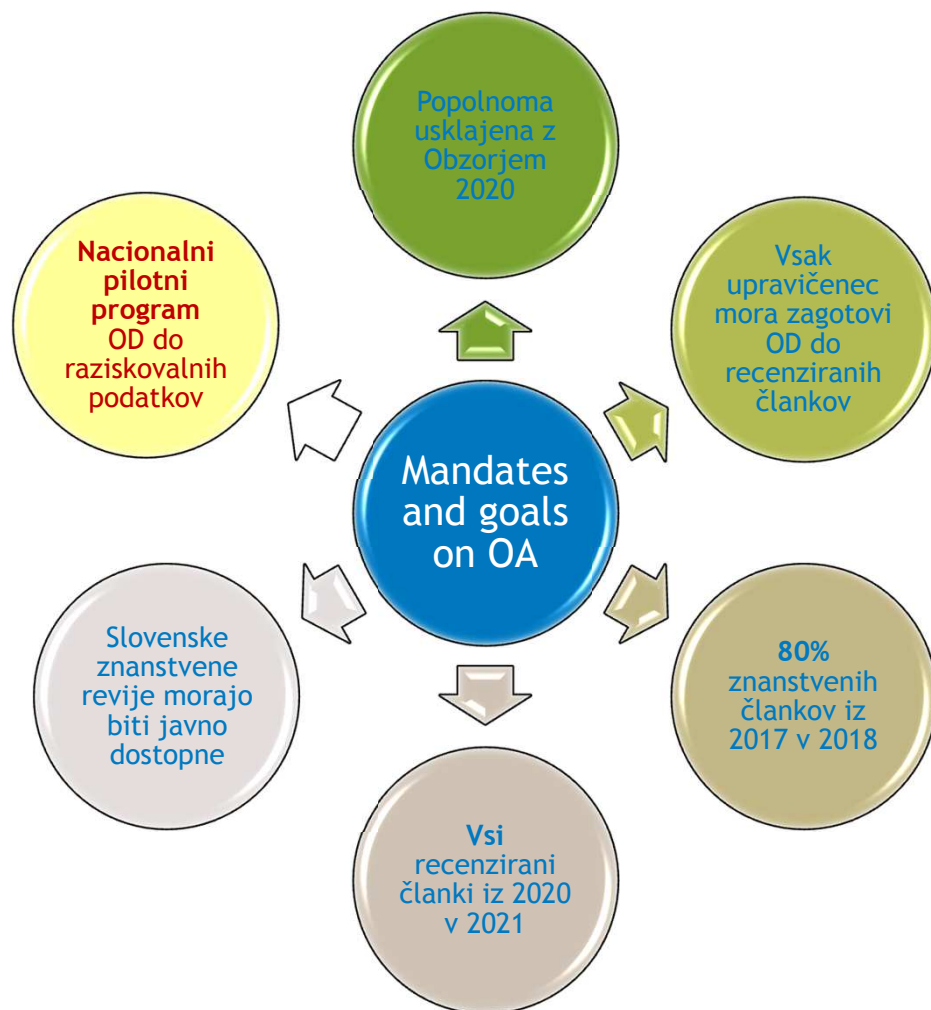

### What Is Open Access (OA)?

Open access can be defined as the practice of **providing on-line access to scientific information that is free of charge to the reader**. In the context of R&D, open access typically focuses on access to 'scientific information' or 'research results', which refers to two main categories:

- **Peer-reviewed scientific research articles** (primarily published in academic journals)
- **Research data**

More details about Horizon 2020 provisions for open access to publications and data is given below.

### OPEN ACCESS TO PUBLICATIONS

Under Horizon 2020, each **beneficiary must ensure open access to all peer-reviewed scientific publications relating to its results**.

Beneficiaries can freely choose between the most appropriate route towards open access for them:

Novice > Open Access in Slovenia

This page is a brief overview of open access situation, research environment and major initiatives in Slovenia for our foreign visitors. The rest of the site is in Slovene only.

**Open Access Situation**

The Government of the Republic of Slovenia adopted the National Strategy of Open Access to Scientific Publications and Research Data in Slovenia 2015-2020 in September 2015 (ROARMAP record) and the action plan in May 2017. Slovenian research performing organizations have not yet adopted the Open Access policies.

Mrs Petra Tramte from the Ministry of Education, Science and Sport was nominated as the National Point of Reference in accordance with the [Commission Recommendation of 17. 7. 2012 on access to and preservation of scientific information](#). She also coordinates the activities of the working group on open access, nominated by the Minister.
